

## 2018 Nutty & 2019 Cookie Dough Information

Congratulations!! Through hard work during a Girl Scout Entrepreneurial Program, you have earned the enclosed Cookie Dough Card. There are so many ways you can “spend” your card.

**Important:** Product Sales Dough Cards are designed to be earned and used by the individual girl and are separate from troop profit (which is earned by the troop) to support troop programming.

\* This Dough Card is to be treated like money. Please keep it safe until used by the Girl Scout. \*

**CARD EXPIRATION: COB Friday, June 5, 2020 NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

**It CANNOT be extended past the Expiration Date**

*Dough may be used toward the fee of Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio (GSSGC) expenses. This includes GSSGC sponsored events, camps and shop purchases. We even offer Banking options, for girls who want to save up their cards – more details below.*

- Check out the **Camps** we offer on GSSGC.org – Girl Scouts can use their Dough towards their camp payment! (*This includes both resident and day camps*). To sign up with Dough, click the “Online Email Registration” link and complete the online form with Dough information!

### **BANK DOUGH: CHECK YOUR BALANCE AT [HTTPS://MPS.BZ](https://mps.bz)**

*We allow Dough Banking for two different programs. This allows girls to bank their dough over the years in order to “save up” for those pricier opportunities.*

- **School Package** is a program offered by GSSGC to help girls earn their school needs on their own; such as, Yearbooks, ASB Packages, Dance Tickets, Senior Photos, Class Rings, Graduation Announcements, Cap/Gown etc. - *we even approve Drivers Ed!* Bank your card today at [http://bit.ly/GSSGC\\_BankingDough\\_SchoolPackage](http://bit.ly/GSSGC_BankingDough_SchoolPackage)
- **ETT/Camp Package** is a program for those who are interested in going on an Extended Trip (with Girl Scout Programming included), a School Field Trip with Educational Programming or attending a GS Approved Camp and need more than 1 years’ worth of dough to afford it. Learn more;

**NOTE:** Dough is NEVER automatically banked for you. You must follow banking procedures each year before expiration.

#### FAQ:

**If a Dough Card is lost, can it be replaced?** Not physically; however, our retail shops can provide the Girl Scout with her card number.

**Can an expired Dough Card be reissued?** No, not under any circumstances. Bank it, or use it now if you think you may forget.

**Where does the unused Dough go once it is expired?** Dough Cards are allocated to capital improvement needs, which includes deferred maintenance on Council camps and properties.

**Can a Dough Card be gifted to another Girl Scout?** Sure it can; just be sure to gift the card with a letter stating it is being gifted that contains signature from both the gifting Girl Scout and her Parent/Guardian.
